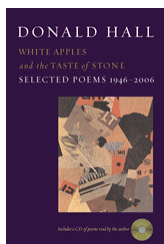


Donald Hall

of the United States



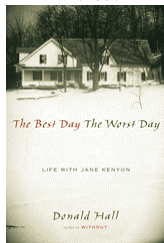
Donald Hall's first book with Houghton Mifflin was *Seasons at Eagle Pond* (1987). Hall has won a National Book Critics Circle Award and the *Los Angeles Times* Book Award for *The One Day* (1989) and a PEN-Winship Award for *Without* (1998). He was the poet laureate of New Hampshire from 1984 to 1989 and again from 1995 to 1999. In 1991, he received the Robert Frost Silver Medal from the Poetry Society of America.
